

Two Online Deaf Ed Courses for Fall Offered by Bloomsburg University

COURSE ONE: 74.201.99 History, Education, and Guidance of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing

Course Description: Students will gain an understanding of basic problems, principles and practices encountered in the education of individuals who are deaf/hard of hearing. Main topics presented are the following: the incidence, definitions, and classifications of hearing loss, the history of education of students who are deaf/hard of hearing, present educational methods, philosophies and programs, and the sociological and psychological aspects of deafness. History, Education, and Guidance of the Dear/Hard of Hearing serves as an excellent gateway into the field of Deaf education.

Other information: The course will be offered via Blackboard and Horizon Wimba, an online content delivery method. The course will be conducted in an asynchronous and synchronous format. Tuesday nights, from 6 to 9 PM (EST) the class will be meeting using Wimba in a lecture style format.

COURSE TWO: 74.469/569.99 Curricular Subjects for the Deaf/Hard of Hearing

Course Description: A capstone course of the Education of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing Program, Curricular subjects deals with the contents and methods of teaching school subjects. Students will be taught methodologies and strategies to teach academic subjects to individuals who are deaf/hard of hearing. In addition, the student will learn to use and identify current teaching aids, materials, and techniques appropriate for teaching deaf/hard of hearing students with an emphasis on language.
