

Bloomsburg University Office of Institutional Research – Frequently Asked Questions

What is the enrollment of the university?

In Fall 2018, there were 8,924 students enrolled. Of these, 7,935 were undergraduate degree seeking students, 318 were undergraduate non-degree students, and 671 were graduate students. The full-time equivalent enrollment (F.T.E. enrollment) was 8,075. Of our overall students, 58.6 percent are female and 91.5 percent are Pennsylvania residents.

How many minority students are enrolled at Bloomsburg University?

In Fall 2018, underrepresented minority students represented 16.1% of the university population. For undergraduates, 16.7% were underrepresented, and for graduate level students, 9.4% were underrepresented.

How many students live on campus?

In Fall 2018, 2,996 students resided on campus in the dormitories, the upper campus apartments, or Kile Apartments.

How many freshmen enrolled in the fall?

In Fall 2018, there were 1,848 new freshmen enrolled. This includes any freshmen who started during the summer and returned in the fall. Of these, 30.1% were first-generation students.

How many faculty & staff are employed at Bloomsburg University?

In Fall 2018, there were 1006 full-time employees and 140 part-time employees at Bloomsburg University. Of these, 405 were full-time instructional faculty and 95 were part-time instructional faculty.

What are the graduation rates for Bloomsburg University?

Bloomsburg's six-year graduation rate for the 2012 first-time, full-time freshmen cohort was 60%. The six-year graduation rate for the 2011 cohort was 58%.

How many degrees does Bloomsburg University award in a year?

In 2017-18, there were 1,821 baccalaureate, 6 post-baccalaureate certificates, 247 master's degrees, and 15 doctoral degrees awarded.

How many degree programs are available at Bloomsburg University?

Bloomsburg currently offers degrees in 57 baccalaureate programs, 17 master's programs, and 2 doctoral programs. We also offer 8 sub-baccalaureate and 5 post-baccalaureate certificates.

What kinds of programs are undergraduate students enrolled?

Of all undergraduate majors, 30.4% are in the College of Science & Technology; 27.9% are in the College of Liberal Arts; 19.6% are in the Zeigler College of Business; 10.5% are in the College of Education; and 11.6% are undeclared.
